#### Notes

1. Mathematics may be taken as one subject (**Mathematics**) or two subjects (Mathematics and Further Mathematics). ICT is Information and Communication Technology.

Students who do not have English as their first language and do not already have A GCSE (grade C or above, or equivalent qualification, in English Language, should take EAL and either 3 or 4 AS subjects.
