



JUNIOR BOARDERS – PREP (YEARS 3 TO 6) GUIDE FOR ADDITIONAL ITEMS TO BRING

Please note that quantities in brackets relate to the recommended quantities for boarders.

BEDDING AND TOWELS

Please note that sheets, pillows and pillowcases are provided by the College but boarding pupils are required to bring:-

(1) Single Duvet (not feather or down)
(2) Single Duvet Covers
(3) Bath Towels
(1) Games Towel

A Boarding pack containing the above (1 x Duvet, 2 x Duvet Cover and 3 x Bath Towel, 1 x Games Towel) is available to purchase from the School Shop for £95.

It is advisable that this item is pre-ordered so that it is in stock ready for when pupils arrive. **AVAILABLE FROM THE SCHOOL SHOP** Email: schoolshop@slcuk.com

ADDITIONAL ITEMS TO BRING

(3) Pyjamas / night dresses
(10) Underwear
(8) Casual socks
(1) Slippers
(1) Dressing gown
(1) Overnight case / bag / rucksack
(1) Sponge bag, toothbrush, toothpaste and toiletries
(1) Hairbrush and comb
(1) Nail brush and scissors
(1) Shoe cleaning kit
(4) Sets of casual clothing (to suit the season)
(1) Casual coat or jacket
(12) Hangers
(1) Wellington boots

In addition the following items are recommended:

Family photographs	Small games e.g. playing cards, dominoes etc.
Cuddly toy	Pencil case containing pens etc.
Favourite book	Spare pair of glasses if glasses are worn
Writing paper and envelopes	

LAUNDRY

The College laundry provides a machine wash service only and whilst every effort is made to adhere to washing instructions on labels, all laundry is processed at the pupil's risk. It is therefore recommended that no 'hand wash only' items are brought and that items should be both washable and tumble-dryable. All machine washable clothes are laundered free of charge.

A dry cleaning service is available at an additional cost.

All articles must be sent in good repair - a charge will be made for mending.

MARKING OF CLOTHES

All items should be clearly labelled with nametapes. E.g. for trousers and skirts on the inside waistband, for shirts, blouses and jumpers at the inside back neck. For boarders nametapes will be ordered automatically and sent to House matrons to name items purchased during term time. For new boarders, if time allows, a duplicate set of nametapes will be sent to your home address to label items.

NAMETAPE FORMAT

Nametapes printed in-house use the following format: - First Name / Surname / (House) Abbreviation
